Albania

Radio Tirana

Radio Tirana is the external service of Radio Televizioni Shqiptar.

Transmitter sites: Although no longer broadcasting from transmitters in Albania, Radio Tirana is on shortwave via Radio Miami International in Okeechobee, Florida and ShortwaveService in Kall, Krekel, Germany.

Usually on the first Saturday of the month there are broadcasts to celebrate the history of Radio Andorra, produced by Christian Milling. The last was on Saturday 2 April 2022 at 1800-1900 on 6180 kHz (via Moosbrunn Austria) with "From the Archives of Radio Andorra", an hour-long Jazz-Show with music from Louis Amstrong, Miles Davis, Marcel Zanini, Bing Crosby, Billie Holiday and Thelonious Monk. Austria

Radio Ö1 International

Radio Austria 1 International (Ö1 International) is the official international broadcasting station of Austria. Austrian Radio 1 (Ö1) is its most successful cultural radio network. The entire programme offering, with just a few changes, is broadcast worldwide as Ö1 International. This mix of information, culture, music, literature, education, science and religion reaches Austrians living abroad as well as a global audience with an interest in Austria. It replaced Radio Österreich International which was discontinued for financial reasons at the end of 2003. Radio Ö1 International added two extra shortwave transmissions beamed to Ukraine on 1 March 2022.

Transmitter site: Moosbrunn (see explanation below).

Rihards Millers confirms that the English language news summary during midday journal of Ö1 (as heard on 13730 kHz) is now a regular fixture (but only on weekdays), but not exclusive to shortwave: cross-checking ORF website confirms that the bulletin airs also on the O1 livestream, likely also on FM. The summaries begin somewhere between 1050-1055 and last around 3 minutes.

Shortwave relays from Österreichische Rundfunksender - Moosbrunn

Transmitter site: Moosbrunn, a municipality in the district of Bruck an der Leitha in the Austrian state of Lower Austria. The transmitting station is owned and operated by Österreichische Rundfunksender GmbH & Co KG. It consists of 2 x 100 kW and 2 x 300 kW shortwave transmitters.

Belarus

Radio Belarus International

Radio Belarus International is the External Service of BRTC. Although there was no longer any external broadcasting from transmitters in Belarus itself, Radio Belarus had until January 2022 daily transmissions via ShortwaveService in Germany. However, these appear to have ceased.

Belgium

Radio Onda

Radio Onda is a licensed Belgian station. Broadcasts are usually made according to the operators' availability.

Transmitter site: Borculo, east Netherlands. It has 2 x 1 kW shortwave transmitters.

Radio Onda began a rebroadcast of Ukrainian TV in early March on 6140 kHz via Borculo, Netherlands. These all day broadcasts are, when on air, more or less parallel to the TV video at at http://www.nrcu.gov.ua/en/ (with a few seconds delay). Julio Roth (the operator of Radio Onda) advised Alan Roe in an email that he intends to keep the relays running all week (as of w/c 7 March) if possible. (various reports, notably Alan Roe); The relay of Ukrainian TV audio on 6140 kHz was on air this morning (10 March) but went silent at 1207 UTC (and is still off air at 1440 UTC). According to OndaShortwave on Facebook (8 March) it was a relay of Hit FM from Ukraine which was carrying non-stop news (presumably audio from the TV news service being carried by all TV stations in Ukraine). Bulgaria

Bulgarian National Radio

Radio Bulgaria ceased broadcasting on shortwave from its own transmitters in Bulgaria on 31 January 2012, but in January 2022 BNR returned to shortwave thanks to Shortwaveservice in Germany which has started airing the "Bulgarien Heute" and "Bulgaria Today" podcasts. These are, however, aired without the agreement of BNR.

Spaceline Bulgaria - Kostinbrod

Spaceline Ltd Bulgaria was established in 1995 in Bulgaria from group of experts in telecommunications, TV and Radio broadcasting with main objective to provide transmission facilities and technical services. It manages the operation of the NURTS-owned transmitting site at Kostinbrod and is a service provider of shortwave radio broadcasting.

Transmitter site: Kostinbrod, a town in western Bulgaria. It is the seat of Kostinbrod Municipality, located 15 km west of the capital city of Sofia. The site has 4 x 50 kW, 3 x 100 kW, and 1 x 250 kW shortwave transmitters (CIRAF zones have been omitted from the schedule below as those registered with HFCC do not always match the intended target area).

KSKO Alsaka relayed via Bulgaria 18 April 2022: Noted whilst reviewing an overnight recording on my SDR was KSKO, Alaska with Paul Walker. The broadcast was from 2200-2400 UTC on 18 April on 5900 kHz. This was a live relay via Bulgaria and replaced the regular Overcomer Ministry broadcast at this time. I didn't notice any advance publicity for this. (Alan Roe, Teddington, UK, BDXC-UK iog); later confirmed by Paul Walker as 2200-0000 on 5900 kHz every Monday.

Czech Republic

Radio Prague International (Český rozhlas 7) is the official international broadcasting station of the Czech Republic.

Transmitter sites: Although shortwave broadcasts directly from the Czech Republic ceased in 2011, Radio Prague International is now heard on Radio Miami International in Florida and ShortwaveService in Germany

TDF International Broadcasting Centre - Issoudun

TDF (which stands for Télédiffusion de France officially renamed TDF in 2004) is a French company which provides radio and television transmission services, services for telecommunications operators, and other multimedia services, digitisation of content, encoding, storage, etc. Its headquarters are located in Paris. It is the dominant partner in the HDRR WiMAX consortium. It is also part of Digital Radio Mondiale.

Transmitter site: The International broadcasting centre of TDF is at Issoudun, a commune in the Indre department, an administrative region of Centre-Val de Loire. The site uses 12 rotary ALLISS antennas fed by 12 transmitters of 500 kW each to transmit shortwave broadcasts by Radio France International (RFI), along with other broadcast services.



The news release by ERT is leaving the possibility of shortwave broadcasts to continue only if the Ministry of Defense and Foreign Ministry decide to oversee the continuation of broadcasts on shortwave.

<u>Update</u>: ERT's Board of Directors after a request by the Ministry of Defense decided to extend the broadcasts of the Voice of Greece via the shortwave transmitting center in Avlis until 31 May 2022. Radio 22 - Uncensored program in Russian for people in Russia on shortwave: the FundRazr page of Radio 22 states the following: "We are going to broadcast an uncensored program in Russian for people in Russia. The technical possibilities have already been clarified. The internet is becoming more and more restricted and sometimes at risk for the Russian people. Right now, uncensored news in Russia is absolutely essential. We draw our motivation from these experiences and see it as a social responsibility to act. The programs will be broadcast on shortwave. Ir is possible to receive that programm with the simplest Radio and the listener is not exposed to the risk of being tracked. Technically everything is ready for the start, and it could start immediately. In addition we have some journalistic partners with us to create a daily program of around 60 minutes in length. The program will be broadcast twice a day. Everyone works for free and even the studios will not earn any fee. The only thing we have to pay is the powerful transmitter. every fund is welcome".

Echo Sthlm

The station's website says "Echo Sthlm is a Stockholm-based, Russian-language radio station where you get unbiased news about Russia and the war in Ukraine. With in-depth discussions and interviews, we convey a picture that is relevant to a broad Russian audience. No censorship – just quality, fact-based content. Echo Sthlm was set up as a reaction to the Russian state's increasing censorship: several Russian radio stations, websites and media outlets have been forced to close down since the invasion of Ukraine. We therefore broadcast both as a podcast on the internet and via shortwave radio, so that listeners in Russia can stay informed despite censorship attempts". The station was set up by former staff of Radio Sweden's Russian service with their first podcast on 18 March 2022. Echo Sthlm made its first shortwave broadcast on 24 March 2022.

Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty is a non-profit media corporation that distributes information on various platforms to audiences in 23 countries in Eastern, Central and South-Eastern Europe, the Caucasus, Central and South Asia in 27 languages. The Corporation, as a private grantee, is funded by funds provided by the US Congress through the US Overseas Broadcasting Trustee, the US Agency for Global Media (USAGM). Although it is not aired on shortwave itself, there are currently daily broadcasts made possible by listener contributions to Shortwaves for Freedom, which purchases the airtime at greatly discounted rates. Ukrainian Radio

Since 22 February 2022, due to the Russian invasion, Ukrainian Radio and all Public Broadcasting platforms have been running an information marathon to provide the latest news on the current situation. They conduct round-the-clock live broadcasting, providing listeners with the most up-to-date and accurate information about the country's defense. Military analysts, leading statesmen and leading experts in topical areas of wartime are guests and live in the marathon. The live broadcast can be interrupted during an air alarm, when the hosts are forced to be in hiding. Immediately after the alarm is removed, the live broadcast on Ukrainian Radio continues (UR website).

Broadcasts of Ukrainian Radio from other countries

Ukrainian Radio is also being broadcast from other countries at the present time. The UR website says "Earlier, due to numerous requests from Ukrainian and foreign radio stations, Ukrainian Radio NSTU allowed the retransmission of its signal on the networks of radio stations of any form of ownership".

Radio Ukraine International is the official international broadcasting station of Ukraine. As a section of the National Radio Company of Ukraine (NRCU) and working from studios located in the heart of the capital city Kyiv, Radio Ukraine International normally has programming and news broadcasts in five languages (English, German, Romanian, Russian and Ukrainian), although external broadcasting on mediumwave and shortwave from Ukraine had already been discontinued before the war and most broadcasts were available online with a relay on shortwave (i.e. via WRMI).

The Viešintos transmitter in Lithuania on 1386 kHz is owned and operated by Radio Baltic Waves International, the Kall transmitter on 6005 kHz is owned and operaqted by ShortwaveService, and the Okeechobee transmitter in Florida is owned and operated by Radio Miami International.

The short bulletins in English are "Ukraine: security issue" which provides actual news about the Russian-Ukrainian war. Every day, Ukrainian Radio prepares a digest of the most important news about the Russian-Ukrainian war in the format of short podcast in English, Polish, Romanian, Slovak, Russian, Belarusian, Bulgarian and Hungarian. UR says "We offer only reliable information from confirmed sources: reports on the course of the war, coverages from cities attacked by russia, as well as news about life in the home front regions of Ukraine. If you want to be aware of the situation in Ukraine, but do not have time to read the news all day - the "Ukraine: security issue" is for you."

The English edition of Ukraine: security issue is available at approximately 0000 UTC. Richard Langley commented on the WOR iog on 9 April 2022: "I believe that "Ukraine: security issue" is only broadcast once per day and is likely recorded and inserted into the audio feed around 0000 UTC (3 am local time). At least it's not mentioned at other times on the schedule. But it might be that certain hours of the schedule are repeated in whole or in part during the 24-hour schedule including the one at 0000 UTC. This is the middle of the night after all. BBC WS output continues with many news programmes each day. Usually, there is a six-minute news bulletin on the hour regardless of target area. Additionally, the following programmes all provide extended news coverage: Newshour, Newsday, Newsroom, BBC OS and Weekend programmes, along with the Focus on Africa programmes. These are all broadcast at various times on shortwave, and with the BBC's complex schedule I have found it quite difficult to keep track of when and where to hear to them. So I have navigated through all of the BBC WS schedules and have compiled this time-ordered summary of when and where to hear the main news programmes each day, which I hope that you will find to be a useful reference.

Additional tests and one-off transmissions may be broadcast from Woofferton at short notice. One such example was on the afternoon of 5 July 2021 when several people reported hearing a test on 15510 kHz and mentioning an email address of transmissiontest@gmail.com. François (surname not known) posted a comment to the British DX Club iog to say that he had sent a report to this address and received a reply from Dave Porter: "Thank you for your report and I confirm the details are correct. These transmissions were to fault-find on a 250/300 kW sender at the UK HF transmitter station at Woofferton in England. These duration of these tests can be variable as the engineers can sometimes need a long time to establish a fault or they may interrupt the test, make an adjustment and resume. This is particularly so if the fault is of an intermittent nature. Encompass Digital Media, Woofferton is the only remaining UK HF sender broadcast station and also is the only one with this transmission test audio and email address. The audio is contained in a file play-out system and incorporates non-copyright music and voice announcements from one of the engineers, Martin, 2E1EKX at the transmitter site".

Volant Media UK Ltd

Volant Media UK Ltd create groundbreaking news content and documentaries aimed at audiences around the world not serviced by mainstream media. Founded in 2017, it is a global organisation with offices in London, Paris and Washington and has a rapidly growing team of journalists and content producers. Broadcasting from state of the art studios in West London, they cover a range of topical and factual stories, with a focus on reaching audiences in and from frontier markets. The two services of Volant Media UK Ltd of interest to shortwave listeners are Iran International and Afghanistan International TV:

Radio Iran International

Iran International is a Persian television station headquartered in London. It is aimed at Iranian viewers and broadcasts free-to-air by satellite. The channel has received media attention for its reporting on human rights violations, political developments, LGBTQ+ rights and women's rights in Iran and has twice been nominated for International Channel of the Year by the Association for International Broadcasting. Iran International was first heard on shortwave on 19 November 2019 with an audio feed from its London-based satellite TV service, seemingly in response to an Internet blackout in Iran caused by civil unrest in several towns and cities.

Radio Afghanistan International

On 15 August 2021, the day the Taliban captured Afghanistan's capital Kabul, Volant Media UK Ltd, the parent company of Iran International, launched Afghanistan International TV (AITV). AITV aspires to serve as an international news network to provide reliable information for audiences and protect media freedom in the country. AITV, which has started with daily nine hours of live television news and programmes, plans to expand to a full 24/7 schedule as soon as possible. AITV also had a radio stream which is already offering 24-hour news and programmes (a shortwave broadcast from AITV were first reported on 16 August 2021).

After that there is a cello sonata from Claude Debussy and the Octet in E Flat Major by Beethoven.

Radio Emma Toc World Service

The 'Radio Emma Toc World Service' is a half hour programme produced by Jim Salmon available on various broadcast stations & online. The aim is to provide a monthly entertainment & information programme - celebrating all things radio! Why 'Emma Toc' ...? Wireless station 2MT at Writtle, near Chelmsford, was required to read out their allocated callsign '2MT' at regular intervals, & in 1922 the British Army phonetic alphabet of the time was used. 'M' was 'Emma' & 'T' was 'Toc', so '2MT' became 'Two Emma Toc'. The amusing & flippant manner in which Captain Peter Eckersley read out the phonetic version of '2MT' resulted in the station being affectionately known as 'Two Emma Toc'! BBC World Service Antarctic Midwinter Broadcast 2023

Every year, the BBC World Service makes a special programme for just a small number of listeners: the team of scientists and support staff isolated at British research stations in the Antarctic midwinter. The Antarctic Midwinter Broadcast is unlike anything else on the BBC World Service. Presented by Cerys Matthews, it features messages from family and friends at home as well as music requests from Antarctica. For decades it has been part of the traditional midwinter celebrations. Vatican Radio is the official broadcasting service of Vatican City. Shortwave transmissions from Vatican Radio have been reduced in recent years in favour of digital distribution but there are still a number of broadcasts mainly to Africa and Asia. **Transmitter sites**: Vatican Radio's transmitting station is located at Santa Maria di Galeria, an extraterritorial area near Cesano (to the north of Rome) belonging to the Holy See. It consists of 4 x 100 kW and 5 x 500 kW shortwave transmitters (currently operating at 125 & 250 kW according to HFCC registrations). Additional relays are via Germany Madagascar. Philippines. Northern Mariana Islands and the USA
